Midsouth Machine & Service Company Adds New Metalworking Equipment

Beginning in December of 2018 and continuing into 2019, Midsouth Machine & Service (MMS) will add metalworking equipment to their Maryville, Tennessee shop.

The first piece of equipment is a Morando Vertical Boring Mill, which has been freshly retrofitted with CNC technology. With its 118" table, MMS will be able to add to its capacity for turning large work pieces up to 40,000 lbs. This mill is scheduled to come on line early February 2019.



The second machine is a Vectrax CNC Knee Mill. This will increase MMS's capabilities for precision machine work. This mill is under power and ready for work.



In early February 2019, MMS will be adding a 400 amp plasma metal cutting table. This table is set up with CNC and will enhance the shop's ability to accurately produce heavy steel parts in a very efficient and cost effective way.

In May 2019, MMS will be adding a submerged arc welding system. This welding system will produce superior welds at a productive pace. This custom system is currently being built in the UK by Lincoln Elect.

These new additions will allow MMS to continue to provide exceptional and innovative service to its customers.
