

Daily Checks & Maintenance HP300 through HP500

- 1. Check oil tank level.
- 2. Check oil inlet and drain line temperatures per factory manual guidelines.
- 3. Check oil pressure at countershaft box per factory manual guidelines.
- 4. Check oil filter differential pressure per factory manual guidelines.
- 5. Check power draw and cavity level.
- 6. Check closed side setting.
- 7. Check cavity release pressure per factory manual guidelines.
- 8. Check clamping pressure per factory manual guidelines.
- 9. Check feed distribution.
- 10. Check that crusher discharge area is clear. Remove any build-up on arms.
- 11. Check counterweight liner and cover for wear.
- 12. Check countershaft coast down time. Should be 30-60 seconds.
- 13. Check for loose fasteners and connections.
- 14. Check for unusual noise, indications of wear or undue strain on crusher parts.
- 15. When crushing liners (mantle & bowl liners) approach their wear limit, check for loose, cracked or worn through liners.
- 16. Check for adjustment ring movement.
- 17. Check oil flow and strainer basket.
